Conference Policy



CONFERENCE POLICY FOR WHIS MUN, 2025

All delegates are requested to read these policies in their entirety. Being a delegate for the Conference implies that the individual has accepted all conference policies and is therefore expected to comply with all of them.

Registration Guidelines

1. All students affiliated and studying in a recognised undergraduate or postgraduate course and high school students are eligible to participate in WHIS MUN.
2. WHIS MUN is open for registration from all interested candidates regardless of past MUN experience and we encourage you to use this conference as a start for your MUN journey.
3. An applicant may be required to furnish proof of some of his mentioned achievements by the Organising Committee if requested.
4. The Secretary General, the Director General and the Deputy Secretary General are the only individuals empowered to make exceptions to any of the rules mentioned as a part of all the policies listed in this document. WHIS MUN 2025 is not liable for any promises/ exceptions made by other members of the Organising Committee regarding fees or policies.
5. The WHIS MUN 2025 Executive Board/Organising Committee reserves the right to amend the country/committee matrix. Also, country and committee allotments are solely at the discretion of the Organising Committee and the Executive Board members.
8. In order to receive a certificate of participation, a delegate has to attend a minimum of 75% of the sessions. In order to receive an award, a delegate must attend all the sessions except in the case of unavoidable circumstances which shall be deemed valid only by the respective Executive Board members and the Secretary General.
7. First-Come-First-Serve policy shall not be entirely applicable to all allotments for WHIS MUN 2025. Delegate allotments will be made on the basis of past Model UN experience to maintain decorum & ensure the highest quality of debate. Preference allotment probability is bound to decrease through the participation timeline.
8. The Executive Board/ Organising Committee has the right to immediately expel delegates from the committee due to unacceptable behaviour. Serious indiscipline on the part of even a single delegate may require the dismissal, without refund, of the individual involved and his or her Delegation from the Conference.
9. The Organising Committee/Executive Board reserves the right to define appropriate Conference behaviour and is particularly strict about issues involving displays of disrespect to other delegates, Executive Board members, Organising Committee, and conference staff.



Secretariat Policies

1. The Secretariat of WHIS MUN 2025, shall have the power to change, amend or modify the conference policies or any other general policies mentioned in this document without any prior notice for the Offline edition of WHIS MUN.
2. WHIS MUN 2025 will be hosted at the campus of Wisdom High International School and Junior College, Govardhan Campus, Nashik.
3. The decision of the Secretariat of WHIS MUN on all the organizational and operational matters shall be considered as final and binding. The decision regarding awards by the Executive Board shall also be considered as final and binding.
4. All delegates must be in their assigned committee rooms throughout committee sessions. Delegates are expected to be on time to all committee sessions and mandatory events.

Conference Policies

1. During the sessions, the delegates are expected to exercise diplomatic courtesy when addressing members of the committee and the dais. The delegates are expected to address the other delegates in the third person. No use of slang or informal terms would be entertained. In addition, delegates are also requested to be polite to all the logistics, press, and other miscellaneous Organising Committee members.
2. The Secretariat reserves the right to immediately expel delegates from the Conference due to unacceptable behaviour. Serious infractions on the part of even a single delegate may require the dismissal, without refund, of the individual.
3. If a delegate is dismissed from the conference, their delegation is automatically disqualified from Conference awards. The Secretariat reserves the right to define appropriate Conference behaviour and is particularly sensitive to issues involving displays of disrespect to other Delegates, Secretariat, Executive Board Members or Conference Staff of WHIS MUN'25.
4. The Delegates shall be held responsible for the replacement/ compensation of any wilful or negligent damage caused to the property at the venue of the Conference.
5. The Delegates are requested to take care of their belongings. The Secretariat shall not be responsible for the loss or any belongings of the Delegate.
6. Committee policies and Rules of Procedure for every committee shall be laid down by the Secretary General along with the Executive Board members for the respective committees. All Executive Board members are free to exercise their freedom to conduct Committee in a way that



they deem best. Motions of censure and impeachment shall not be entertained against any Executive Board member for the duration of WHIS MUN 2025.

Award Policy

1. WHIS MUN does not believe in providing monetary awards to school students, therefore the same will be rewarded in the form of gifts, prizes or awards.
2. The winners of college committees will receive their cash prize after the closing ceremony of WHIS MUN 2025.

Other Rules

1. All the participants are requested to be present on time. Shuttle services will be provided for delegates from the Serene Meadows Campus (SMC) to the Govardhan Campus (GOC) for all delegates, and from the accommodation to the conference venue for outstation delegates
2. The languages entertained for communication and debate are strictly restricted to English for the UN Committees and English and Hindi for the Indian Committees.
3. Any photo, video and other audio/visual material taken and/or recorded during WHIS MUN 2025 featuring any delegate may be used and published for promotional purposes by the organizers of WHIS MUN.
4. Accommodation will only be provided to outstation delegates.

Refund Policy

1. The conference fee is strictly NON-REFUNDABLE, under any circumstances whatsoever. If a delegate withdraws from the conference, there is no provision for a refund of the registration fee already paid.

Dress Code

1. Dress code for the conference is Indian Traditionals on Day 1 and Western Formals/Semi Formals for Day 2 respectively.
2. Inappropriate clothing is strictly discouraged.



Contraband Policy

1. Consumption or possession of any non-prescribed drugs, cigarettes, e-cigarettes, and/or alcohol is strictly prohibited in school premises and Socials venue.
2. If the delegate is caught in possession of or consuming the above-mentioned contraband inside the campus, the Secretariat of WHIS MUN, and Faculty and Staff of Wisdom High Group of Schools, reserve the right to take strict actions against the delegate.
3. There will be a check wherein if any contraband is found, will be confiscated by the authorities.
4. If the Delegate refuses to comply with the checking or confiscation, then they shall not be allowed to enter the premises.

Sexual Harassment and Discrimination Policy

Sexual Harassment and Discrimination are not permitted - WHIS MUN will not tolerate any instances of discrimination based on race, color, sex, gender, gender identity, sexual identity, national origin, religion, age, socioeconomic status, and/or ability. If any delegate or advisor believes they have encountered discrimination, which has resulted in a hostile working environment, they should bring it to the attention of the Organising Committee. They may also bring it to the attention of any member of WHIS MUN Secretariat.

WHIS MUN will involve the appropriate personnel, which may include advisors and faculty members from Wisdom High Group of Schools, and will take appropriate action which may include:

1. Suspension from committee,
2. Disqualification from individual awards,
3. Expulsion from WHIS MUN without refund,
4. Ban the individual or delegation from attending WHIS MUN in the future, and/or :
5. Any other action deemed necessary and appropriate.

Force Majeure

WHIS MUN reserves the right to cancel the conference in the case of extreme or unavoidable circumstances. In the case of cancellation, no remuneration shall be provided in those circumstances.
